79% of teachers organize class travel in part to broaden students' horizons

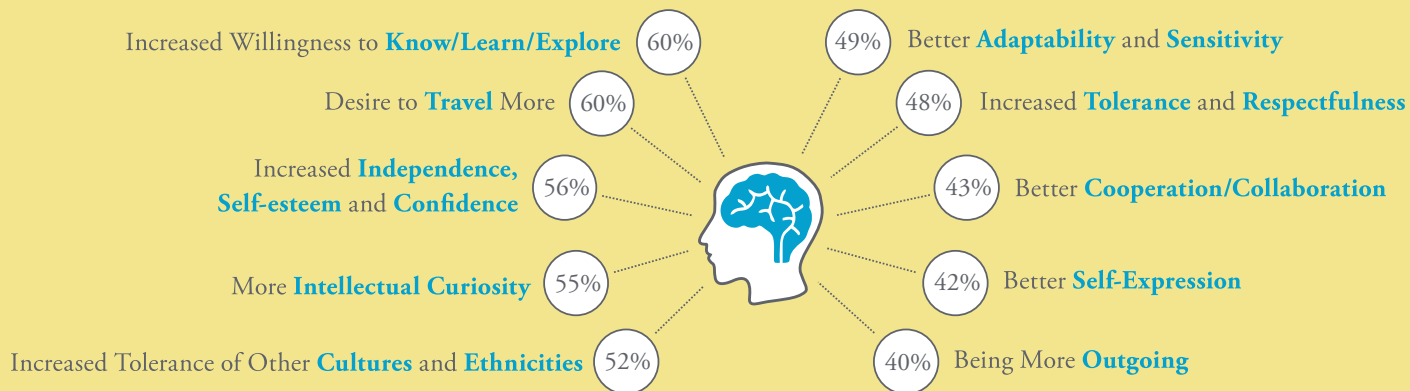
74% of teachers believe travel has a very positive impact on student development
